POVERTY, RACE, AND ABORTION: WHAT NOBODY HAS TOLD YOU

Star Parker is the founder and president of the Center for Urban Renewal and Education (CURE), a Washington D.C. based public policy institute that promotes market-based solutions to fight poverty. Today, CURE leads a network of 800 pastors serving in at-risk communities across the country. Star speaks about how abortion is dehumanizing to the African American community, how abortion is connected to poverty, race, and welfare. Star has spoken on more than 225 college campuses, she has authored several books, and she’s a regular commentator on national television and radio networks, as well as a nationally syndicated columnist with Creators, reaching 7 million readers weekly.
